What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid is a simple government initiative which allows Tourette Scotland to increase the value of your donations at no extra cost to you.

For every £1 you give to us we can get an extra 25 pence from the HMRC, helping your donation go further to help those who benefit from our charity.

Example:

Your Pledge	Reclaimed Tax at Basic Rate	Tourette Scotland Receives
£5	£1.25	£6.25
£10	£2.50	£12.50
£25	£6.25	£31.25
£50	£12.50	£62.50
£100	£25.00	£125.00

How do I know if I can Gift Aid my donations?

The only condition is that you are a UK taxpayer.

How do I know if I am a UK taxpayer?

Reclaimed Tax at If you have a salary, savings in a bank and / or building society, investments or a pension you may well be a UK taxpayer, so you can Gift Aid your donations.

Will this affect my tax status?

No.

Do I have to tell HMRC about my donations?

No - but if you pay the higher rate of tax, it may be worthwhile.

How do I cancel a declaration?

All you need to do is drop us an email at any time telling us you wish to cancel your declaration.
